

## Restoration Project works with the victims, whenever possible.

Christian Recovery Counseling offers individual Play Therapy for children and individual and/or group therapy for adolescent survivors of sexual abuse. In cases where reconciliation is appropriate and it is not possible to work directly with the victim, the program develops a collaborative working arrangement with the therapist/agency representing the victim and/or family. Decisions are made in collaboration with team consultation as outlined below.

The Restoration Project views reconciliation between the offender and victim as a privilege—not a right. The offender must earn the privilege to apologize to the victim by completing **all** pre-reconciliation goals and requirements established in the offender's treatment plan. Reconciliation can only happen if the victim, family, probation officer, social services, therapists working with the victim, group members and staff are in agreement that it is appropriate.

## QUESTIONS/CONCERNS

### Is group therapy covered by insurance?

Most insurance plans cover group therapy. Check with your insurance plan to be sure.

### Is financial assistance available?

### May I join a group already in progress?

Yes. All the groups are open groups, meaning new clients can join at any time. Upon your acceptance into the program, you are assigned to a specific Restoration Project group.

### Do I need to have an individual therapist to participate in a group?

Yes. When you are accepted into the program you will be assigned an individual therapist whom you will meet with every other week.



## Program Information

The Restoration Project (RP) is a **court recognized treatment program** serving the community at large, including the seven county metro area and beyond. Operating since 1995, we strive to maintain collaborative working relationships with probation officers, child protection workers, guardians, social workers and psychologists in all cases involved. Ninety percent of Restoration Project clients are court ordered.

## Restoration Project

### Counties Accepted:

Over the years we have worked with the following counties: Anoka, Hennepin, Dakota, Ramsey, Olmstead, Pine, Milaca, Washington, Rice, Isanti, Polk (WI), Chisago, Wright, Sherburne, Martin, Rock and the State of MN Department of Corrections.

### Former Graduate Statistics:

- 1 person of 68 have committed an additional sexual offense.
- Additional sex offense within 5 years of graduation: 1.5%
- Additional sex offense within 10 years of graduation: 1.5%
- Additional criminal offense within 5 years of graduation: 5%
- Additional criminal offense within 10 years of graduation: 5%

### CRC also offers these services:

- Couples Group to encourage partners to participate in the healing process.
- Supervision/Chaperone Training

## Who should attend the Restoration Project?

The Restoration Project serves adult men who have committed a sexual offense/s. The program supports recovery for individuals with offenses including but not limited to: contact offenses against children, possession of child pornography, rape, "statutory rape," sexual contact with a vulnerable adult, and exposure.

The Restoration Project also welcomes adult women who have sexually offended, providing treatment in an individual as opposed to group format.
